

Subject: Curing Trypanosomosis and scab in Dromedaries (*Camelus dromedarius*)

Problem: Trypanosomosis and scab

Therapy:

- Scabs can be cured by using Ivermectin, but you should read the indications on the package leaflet. The scabs can be drug resistant to *Ivermectin*.
- Against Trypanosomosis our first choice therapy is the use of *Cymelarsan* (Rhone-Merieux). Other possibilities are *Suramin* (Nagano1IR, Bayer) or *Quinapyramine* (TrypacideR, Rhone-Merieux). Read and follow the indications on the package leaflet.

The availability of the different drugs may vary per country.
